$summer, warm, sunny$ are 0-ary relation symbols, i.e. propositional symbols.

A successful derivation of $happy$:

A failed derivation of $happy$

$happy \Rightarrow summer, \underline{warm} \Rightarrow summer, \underline{sunny}$
